Manuscript preparation and Submission

- a. Manuscript should not have been submitted in a peer-reviewed journal in the same or a very similar version, or in another language.
- b. Manuscript should not have been under consideration for publication in any other peer-reviewed journal.
- c. Topic should be within Official Statistics and related disciplines.
- d. Manuscript should follow Journal style guide.
- e. Manuscript MS-Word files should be submitted to the Chief- in- editor through the following email: head.drpc@eastc.ac.tz
- f. Deadline for submission is strictly observed.
- g. Manuscripts should be blinded before submission by removing all identifying information including file naming. Manuscripts with identifying information will not be accepted.
- h. Manuscripts should be written in English language. The language editing is solely the authors' responsibility.

The authors are required to submit:

a separate title page with the following information

- **Title:** should not contain more than 20 words
- **Authors information** (name, affiliation, full postal address and email address)- start with the 1st Author

- **Abstract:** The abstract should be short (maximum 200 words) summarizing content of the manuscript
- **Key words:** A maximum of five (5) key words are allowed separated by hyphens
- **Acknowledgements:** Should be very brief, about two to three sentences.

Content of the manuscript

Main text: introduction (maximum 10-15% of the total word count), methodology, results and discussion, conclusions and recommendations.

All titles: are to be left justified, capitalized and bold. Sub-titles should be left justified, bold and not capitalized.

Margins: 2 cm on all sides.

Line spacing: 1.5.

Font size: 12.

Font type: Times New Roman.

Pages: number of pages should not exceed 25 including references.

Sections: should be numbered.

spelling check: United Kingdom English dictionary.

Tables, Figures/diagrams, charts: A table should be numbered and have a caption above it. A figure/diagram/ charts should be numbered and have a caption below it.

Number as Table 1, Table 2 etc., and refer to all of them in the main text

Number figures as Fig. 1, Fig. 2, etc. and refer to all of them in the main text.

Font size in table: 10

Mathematics: Equations should be numbered, with the number placed to the right of the equation.

Number format: use a zero before decimal points 0.27, not .27

Reference format: Journal follows American Psychological Association (APA) 6th edition style reference
